## Examining the Connection between Psychiatry, Psychology and the Law

**Established in the late 1970s, the Australian and New Zealand Association of Psychiatry, Psychology and Law (ANZAPPL) is committed to exploring the relationship between psychiatry, psychology and the law.**

**Its purposes are to:**

- Promote co-operation and communication between the disciplines of psychiatry, psychology and law and related fields;
- Promote research into issues and problems in forensic psychiatry, forensic psychology and areas of law and other disciplines in which psychiatry and psychology are relevant
- Promote informed public and professional discussion about contemporary issues in forensic psychiatry, forensic psychology and areas of law and other disciplines in which psychiatry and psychology are relevant; and
- Disseminate information regarding research and developments in forensic psychiatry, forensic psychology and areas of law and other disciplines in which psychiatry and psychology are relevant.

Each year ANZAPPL sponsors a Congress hosted by one of its branches, featuring an international keynote speaker. In addition, branches organise regular activities such as dinner meetings, symposia and workshops. ANZAPPL also produces a journal, *Psychiatry, Psychology and Law*, which has been published twice a year since 1993.

Where appropriate, participation in ANZAPPL activities may be applied to professional continuing education requirements.

ANZAPPL is interested in any discussion or study which involves the interaction between psychiatry, psychology and the law. Topics of particular and on-going interest are:

- Forensic issues in substance abuse
- Mentally disordered offenders
- Intellectual disability and the law
- Mental health legislation
- Children, families and the law
- Ethical issues of forensic practice
- Violence
- Psychopathy
- The forensic aspects of gambling
- Sex offending
- Expert evidence
- Psychiatric / psychological injury
- Post traumatic stress disorder and the law

Membership of ANZAPPL is not restricted to psychiatrists, psychologists or lawyers but is open to anyone with and interest in the relationship between mental health and the law. Members are notified of all events organised by their branch and the international body, receive a reduced fee for ANZAPPL activities, and receive the ANZAPPL journal, *Psychiatry, Psychology and Law*.
